

Reaching for the STARS!

Heritage Provider Network's commitment to achieving 5-Star Quality Care

> Heritage Provider Network's (HPN) overarching goal is to achieve the highest standards of quality care throughout our organization.

We do this by removing barriers to enhance the quality improvement process and by providing our medical groups with the necessary tools to accomplish this goal. Meeting quality standards for initiatives, such as the CMS 5–Star program, is paramount to our organization's future success and reinforces our commitment to provide our members with the best possible care.

The CMS 5–Star Quality Rating System is a quality initiative focused on quality of care, customer service, and the value and affordability of the care for seniors enrolled in Medicare Advantage plans. CMS is looking at how well we meet the HEDIS (Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set) metric goals, the patients' perception of the quality of care they receive and our ability to deliver high quality healthcare at a lower overall cost. Attaining a 5–Star rating is imperative to HPNs ability to secure our position in the future health care delivery system. Ultimately, underperforming medical groups will see a decrease in reimbursement, and possibly, a loss of membership.

As an example, Regal, Lakeside and Affiliates (RLA) is facing the challenges of quality improvement head on by

implementing initiatives to improve quality across their medical groups. In an effort to achieve a 5–Star rating, the Regal, Lakeside and Affiliates' Quality Improvement department assembled a STAR POWER Team to develop comprehensive tools and a training program to educate the medical offices on the components of the new CMS ratings system and how to achieve the 5–Star office experience.

Recognizing that achieving 5–Star quality is not only dependent on the care provided by our medical offices, but also by the actions of everyone in the organization, RLA is developing a broader quality initiative to be deployed at every level. A team of key stakeholders has been tasked with developing and implementing a strategy to infuse quality improvement into every aspect of RLA, making it the driving force behind all decisions. The goal is to create awareness around this initiative and encourage team members to join, develop, enhance and facilitate the process of quality improvement. Everyone in the organization plays a role in providing quality service and everyone is empowered to initiate change.

Focusing on quality improvement enables us to achieve our goal of meeting the quality metrics laid out before us in the CMS 5–Star initiatives. In turn, this success will benefit Heritage California ACO, and other quality mandates in our future – a future that delivers better, more affordable healthcare.

Providers utilizing Continuing Medical Education to deliver higher quality care

Continuing Medical Education (CME) is an excellent vehicle for keeping our providers in the quality loop. Desert Oasis Health Care (DOHC), HPNs accredited CME provider, continually looks for ways to improve the quality of care and services and finds that offering CME is an important way to attain this goal. CME lectures are based on quality improvement goals, 5–Star measures, yearly provider needs assessment surveys, and utilization management trends.

Through collaboration with DOHC, Sierra Medical Group, High Desert Medical Group and Regal, Lakeside and Affiliates also offer CME to their providers. As with DOHC, these groups utilize CME as a way to promote quality care and contribute to the development of our healthcare providers.
